### **DEVOTIONAL EXCERPT**

Having just taxied with a squirming toddler, my flight was suddenly delayed. "Oh no, please Lord, don't let it be an hour," I prayed. "Pray something else!" I felt God say. So, I asked for what I needed to endure this: "Lord, give me grace to look after my child for as long as this delay takes."

I learnt a valuable lesson that day about God's "good, pleasing and perfect will". (Romans 12:2). Sometimes, He isn't just going to 'airlift' me out of tough times; He wants me to seek His strength and presence through them. I think this is part of what Paul means when he calls us to be a "living sacrifice."

Of course, we can always pray for rescue. But perhaps we can learn to seek something deeper too: "Lord, show me Your will in this; give me what I need to endure it."
